Dramatizes a case of child rape and murder in which the inhabitants of a village engage in pursuit and arrest of the perpetrators and are faced with the question of justice. Based on actual cases in Pakistan.

Autobiographical one-person play whose main character is abducted by the Taliban while on assignment for Pakistan Television. The abduction occasions a flood of personal and philosophical reflection.
